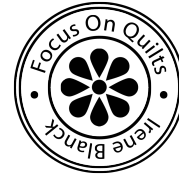


# FOCUS ON QUILTS

| <p><b><u>Centre Squares for baskets</u></b><br/>I used 8 different grey fabrics.<br/>An 8" strip of fabric will give you 5 baskets. Cut each square at 6 ½" x 6 ½"</p> | <p><b><u>Baskets</u></b><br/>I used large florals in various colours for the basket body and handle. For the base and lip of the basket I used fabric with smaller prints, choosing a colour from the large florals</p> | <p><b><u>Flanged border/binding (2 ½")</u></b><br/>Orange/white stripe fabric</p>                                       |
| <p><b><u>2nd, 3rd and 4th Border</u></b><br/>2 ½ yards - of a dark grey fabric. I used Grey Matters but I don't think its available anymore (sorry...)</p>             | <p><b><u>Rectangles</u></b><br/>1 ½" squares papers. You need 112 squares.<br/>(I cut these to 1 ½" x 1")</p>   | <p><b><u>Fabric for Rectangles</u></b><br/>I used the same large florals for all rectangles.</p>                        |
| <p><b><u>Fabric for 3rd Border</u></b></p>   |   |   |
| <p><b><u>Leaves</u></b> - I used 3 different greens and a blue/white stripe on the long borders. I used a third green fabric for the leaves in the corner blocks.</p>  | <p><b><u>Vine</u></b> - I used a black/white fabric. You will require 71" of a ¼" stem.</p>   | <p><b><u>Flowers/Birds</u></b> - An assortment of fabrics. Bring fat quarters, fat eights and lots of other fabric.</p> |

| <p><b>Pattern</b><br/>The pattern will be available from Paperpieces in Paducah.</p>  | <p><b>Light Box</b><br/>Essential for the class</p>  |
| <p><b>Needles</b><br/>I use Jeana Kimball No. 10 straw needles but bring your favourite</p>    | <p><b>Glue</b><br/>Roxanne's glue - I like this small bottle as it has a small "spout" which is easy to unplug if any glue gets stuck in it.</p>  |

| <p><b>Spray Starch</b><br/>Best Press - available from any good quilting shops.</p>   | <p><b>Clover Bias Maker</b><br/>1/4 inch Clover Bias Tape Maker and a metal pin (not with a plastic head as it will melt when pressing)</p>      |
| <p><b>Fabric Pens</b></p> <p><b>Fabric Markers</b></p> <p>Frixion pens are great as they disappear with heat. I usually use the black pens. These are the two that I use. The retractable pens have a fine point<br/><b>(Pilot FriXion Clicker Retractable Gel Ink Pens, Eraseable, Fine Point 0.7 mm, Black Ink (314505P))</b></p>  <p>I also love the felt tipped pens which are great for ease of drawing.<br/><b>(FriXion Colors Erasable Marker Pen s, Bold Point, Assorted Color Inks - 12-Pack (44155))</b></p>  <p>These products are available from Amazon.</p> <p>White gel pen for dark fabrics<br/>Pencils, Permanent marker</p> <p><b>Or bring your favourite fabric pens</b></p> |  |
