Les Fleurs d'Anne

This trio of botanical panels is based on the book of hours, Les Grandes Heures d'Anne de Bretange, which was commissioned by Anne of Brittany, Queen of France, and illuminated by Jean Bourdichon between 1503 and 1508. The Renaissancestyled illustrations throughout the book are typically of one plant. We combined several of the designs to create each of our wool appliqué panels, including several flowers and a few critters, as well.

In this class, you will be able to choose which panel you wish to work on, but we will cover the skills and embroidery stitches for all three blocks, including several techniques for adding dimension to your work. Your class enrollment will include the pattern of your choice and some 4mm silk ribbon. You will have the option to purchase the other two patterns, as well as thread kits and wool kits, if desired. The thread and wool kits will be sufficient to create all three blocks.

Basic sewing supplies needed:

- Thread for appliqué (fine cotton, silk, or poly—we use Aurafil 50 or 80 wt cotton or
- Invisafil 100 wt) to match fabrics
- Strong thread for ruching and basting (40-50 wt cotton or polyester)
- Needles: appliqué, #22 chenille, large milliners needles (size 1 or 3)*
- Scissors: sharp embroidery scissors and paper scissors
- Straight pins
- Chalk pencil or white gel pen (or your favorite marking pencil)*
- Tweezers*
- Small ruler
- Soft Fuse
- Freezer paper

- Floss: variegated green, dark red, brown, light purple, yellow
- Pearl cotton #5: golden yellow, teal, variegated green
- Black crewel wool

Poppies

Wool-

- 8"x17" gold
- 7"x7" green
- 7"x5.5" red
- 4"x2.5" purple
- 2"x2" teal
- 2"x2" orange
- 2"x3" brown

Threads—

- Floss: variegated green, dark red, brown
- #5 pearl: golden yellow, teal, variegated green
- Black crewel wool

Rose of Sharon

Wool—

- 8"x17" gold
- 7"x7.5" green
- 2"x2" red
- 1.5"x3" purple
- 1"x3" teal
- 2.5"x4" orange
- 1"x1" brown
- 4.5"x6" white

Threads—

- Floss: variegated green, dark red, brown, light purple, yellow
- #5 pearl: golden yellow, teal, variegated green
- Black crewel wool







NOTE: We used black flannel as a background for the panels; 1 yard will be sufficient for all three.
