

Prairie Garden Requirements List

Allows for fussy cutting in Chain of Squares and Lattice Borders

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| Background 1 - Centre block: 70cm/¾yd (French General – Chafarcani)) | Pot body – Fat ¹/8 (Di Ford Hall, Chesapeake 9326 blue) | Pot rim – 8" x 3" strip |
| Gold inserts in pot body - 4" square | Gold handle knobs – scrap | Stems 30cm / ¹/3yd of 3 greens (Can use only one if preferred) |
| Leaves – Small amounts of a variety of greens or Fat ¹/8 of one | Flowers – Small amounts of 5 pinks, 2 reds, 3 rusts, 2 golds & 1 purple OR Fat ¹/8 of each colour | Black Striped Borders – 2 mt/2¼yd (Di Ford Hall, Chesapeake 9333 blue) |
| Background Corner Setting Triangles – 60cm / 2/3 yd (Christopher Wilson Tate, Regency Blues 4230717 | Feature Setting Triangles and Squares (Dutch Heritage, Antique Textiles Company, 4001) – 2.1Mt / 2¼yd | Background 3 – Vine Border 1.3Mt / 1½yd |
| Cable Border– 70cm/¾ yd of 2 fabrics for bias | 30cm of 15–20 fabrics for scrappy borders Smaller amounts can be used, and these can be added to as required | Background 4 – Chain of Squares scrappy border 1 – 40cm / ½yd (I've used same fabric as in background corner setting triangles |
| Background 5 - Eight Pointed Stars 1.4Mt / 1½yd | Eight-Pointed Star Octagon centres 20cm / ¼yd | Outer black border and Lattice strips – 2.2Mt/2½yd |
| Background 6 Lattice Border 70cm / ¾yd | Backing - for 3 drops, each, without joins- 6.9 mt / 7yds | Binding - 80cm / ⅞yd |
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| Aurofil Cotton Mako 50 or 80 weight (or preferred thread) to match fabrics for Appliqué | Aurofil Cotton Mako 40 (or preferred thread) for hand and machine piecing | Freezer paper 1mt /1yd, to start, if foundation piecing | Applipops or Perfect Circles (optional) |
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| Rotary cutting equipment (Rotary cutter, ruler & cutting mat) | Quilter's Quarter Add a Quarter / Quarter Plus to mark seams for hand piecing | Mechanical pencil including coloured leads if using dark fabrics (0.7mm 2B is best) *Non-acidic silver gel pen | Clover ¼" Fusible Bias Maker Clover ¼" Fusible Web or glue if preferred |
| Template plastic, or equivalent, to make templates I like to use heavy non-iron interfacing to make templates for applique | Pins for piecing & applique | Appliqué and hand piecing needles | Scissors for cutting paper, fabric, & thread |
| Stapler & staple remover (if foundation piecing) | Old sewing machine needle & spare needles for foundation piecing | Sewing Machine | Note - A 28mm rotary cutter is best if cutting around acrylic templates |

Acrylic templates are available for the Eight-Pointed Star blocks within this quilt. They are recommended for ease & accuracy of cutting and piecing
