Two Contrasting Fabrics along with a third color for your flowers: Quantity according to the Fabric Requirements on the back of your chosen pattern (100% cotton) or you can find them here: <https://pacificrimquilt.com/requirements/>

Your fabrics should be solid or nearly-solid colors. Choose two colors with strong contrasting values. They may be light and dark of the same color or two different colors. I ALWAYS prewash my fabrics. Prewash and press fabrics.”

You will also need one yard of your 3<sup>rd</sup> fabric. This will be more than enough for any of the above patterns.

2 Color Kits are available here: <https://pacificrimquilt.com/hawaiiankits/>. If you choose a kit you will want to also bring 1 yard of your flower fabric. Also, if you purchase a kit, please pre-purchase the kit, prewash and press the fabrics and bring them with you.

Practice fabrics: Two 12” square pieces of contrasting fabrics. These will be used to practice the needleturn techniques

Milliners/Straw Needles size 10 or 11

Needle for basting

Threads for Applique: one that matches your applique fabrics

Thread for basting: color not important

Thread snippers and paper scissors

Fabric shears: good enough to cut through 8 layers of fabric. 8" Gingher shears or equivalent.

Straight pins

Pencil or pen: Permanent or temporary (no ball-point pens)

Masking tape – Not blue painter's tape

Optional items: Reading glasses, thimble, needle threader, portable light.
